June 2004 to Present	<b>Freelance Sound Engineer:</b> I have worked on a wide variety of shows from corporate to rock and roll, one offs to tours to festivals to installations, in a number of different roles including FOH engineer, Monitor Engineer, Patch Technician and 'babysitter' roles.
